



Competition Lines—Basic Information for 2016-2017

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Welcome Back! Summer flew by with Nationals in Wisconsin Dells, the Rivertown Days Parade, and summer classes. Congratulations dancers for your performances at Midwest Starz Nationals 2016 in the Wisconsin Dells. Over 180 dancers earned 1st place and/or platinum awards at the biggest nationals event ever! 50 dancers earned the title of “Grand National Champion” at the callback event. This includes Giant Clog and Purple Clog. Congratulations to everyone-you performed your best under the National spotlight!

FALL OPEN HOUSE & SHOE SWAP: Tuesday, August 16th at the Studio from 5pm-8pm. (In- person registration) All dancers may register by mail if they prefer. Registration forms and information were emailed out and are available online. **Selling used shoes?** Bring in your previously worn shoes to the shoe swap so you can try to sell them. Do not just drop them off to sell as we have no one to supervise the sale of them. You may also list them in the “Used Shoes for Sale” book.

VACATION SCHEDULE:

Thanksgiving: No classes Wed, Nov. 23 through Sat, Nov. 26. Classes resume Monday, Nov. 28th.

Christmas: No classes Mon., December 19 through Fri., December 30. Classes resume Monday, Jan 2nd.

Spring Break: No classes Mon., March 13 through Fri., March 17. Classes resume Monday, March 20th.

No Competitions will be attended March 10-13 or March 17-19.

Last Week of Classes: Mon, May 22 through Fri, May 27.

TENTATIVE REVUE DATES: Friday, June 2nd through Sunday, June 4th.

TECHNIQUE CLASSES: All students on a Competition Line grades 5 and up must attend technique classes weekly. Comp line students grades 3-5 must attend 3 classes of technique per month. **THIS INCLUDES STUDENTS IN CLOGGING.** You may attend as many technique classes as you want for the same fee! Use our NEW Open technique on Fridays 4:00-4:45pm as well.

BALLET CLASSES: Extra ballet classes are recommended for all dancers; however **ALL solo, duet, trio, Emerald, Purple, Omni, Ruby Jazz & Lyrical dancers are REQUIRED to take a Ballet class in addition to technique.**

ATTENDANCE POLICY: All classes missed must be made up by attending an additional technique class to prevent suspension from a line. For example, if you miss a jazz, clogging and technique class on Monday, you must make up those classes by attending 3 additional technique classes. You can attend any technique class for the makeup. Many dancers used the Friday ballet/technique class for this purpose.

DRESS CODE: GIRLS: All girls must wear a leotard. Jan will place an order for any leotards you want. See desk. If you want to layer a tight fitting tank top over it with shorts or leggings, that is fine. Please NO T-shirts over the leotard, we need to see body lines to correct the dancers. As always, tights and kneepads are recommended for floor work (standard volleyball type is fine or even a thinner variety). All hair must be pulled back in a ponytail/bun and off the face. **BOYS:** Wear knit shorts and T-shirts or sweats. Kneepads are recommended for floor work (standard volleyball type is fine or even a thinner variety).

SHOES NEEDED:

Technique class: All competition line dancers **MUST** wear ballet shoes (any color, canvas/leather) OR Paul Wright 1/2 ballets

Jazz, Novelty, Contemporary, and Lyrical classes: Paul Wright half ballet in tan.

Clogging Shoes by Line: (Dancer's feet **MUST BE SIZED** by Oct. 1st because the sample sizers must be returned to the manufacturer.)

Pre-comp Girls:	White 12F Tap Shoes
Diamond	White 20W "Growing Girl" (Graduated Taps)
Turquoise, Blue, Gold	White 720s with Steven Stompers
Super Clog, Emerald Clog, Giant Clog	Black 720s with Steven Stompers

Pre-comp Boys:	Black 12F Tap Shoes
All other lines:	Black 720s with Steven Stompers

Hip Hop: Clean tennis shoes

Pointe: See your teacher, I can order for you if you know the brand and style number.

2016-2017 Estimated Expenses:

Costume down payments will be \$75 per costume per dancer with the first payment due October 1st. If you are in more than one routine, you may pay the \$75 in installments, but all down payments must be received by December 1st. The cost per costume averages between \$110-\$220 for beginning lines and \$125-\$300 for intermediate and advanced lines. A second down payment of \$25 per costume is due February 1. **Competition Line costumes are ordered October 1. No refunds will be given if you drop after Oct. 1st. (Reminder: Dropping classes requires written notice.)** Solo/duet costumes must be given to Jan by October 1st if she is ordering them.

Competition Entry Fees average \$40-\$50 per routine. These fees include 4 regional competitions as well as Nationals entry fees and rehearsal fees. We have broken the entry fees into 2 installments. The first payment of \$100 per routine per dancer is due with your November tuition. You may pay in installments, but all down payments must be received by Dec. 1st. The final installment is due with your Feb tuition. You will be entered in all competitions regardless of whether you attend. The amount of the second installment will be finalized later. Nationals are for everyone on a line. National dates are not yet available, but will be in either June or July.

2016-2017 Competition Line Payment Schedule

Payments are due to Jan in the Studio on the first week of each month. Your class tuition is broken into 9 equal payments. If you are paying by check, note the student name and line on the check. Also note what the check is for and attach the month's voucher from your payment book.

Sept	Tuition, Registration (\$15), Technique Fees – ½ year (\$65)
Oct	Tuition, Costume down payment (\$75 / costume)
Nov	Tuition, Competition entry fee down payment (\$100 / routine)
Dec	Tuition (All costume & entry fee down payments are due)
Jan	Tuition, Technique Fee – 2nd ½ year (\$65)
Feb	Tuition, Costume 2nd payment (\$25 / costume)
Mar	Tuition, Competition entry fee final balance (Jan will notify you of amount)
Apr	Tuition, Costume Final balance (Jan will notify you of final balance due)
May	Tuition

REMINDER: If you intend to drop a class or quit, you must send **WRITTEN NOTIFICATION** to Jan. If you do not send a notice, you will be billed for classes until this notification is received. Calling, leaving a message or not attending class is not sufficient. Costumes are ordered Oct. 1st. Costume fees will not be refunded for students dropping after Oct. 1st.
