## **General Information:**

**Costumes:** If you are enrolling in a combination class (example: Tap/Ballet/Jazz), one style of dance will be performed at the Christmas Show and a different style at the Spring Revue. The Christmas Show costumes are borrowed from the studio. You will need to purchase the costume for the Spring Show. (average cost for non-competition class costumes is \$60-\$70)

**DANCE ATTIRE AND DRESS**: Boys should wear knit shorts and T-shirts or sweats. Girls should wear a leotard and tights. You can wear a skirt, biker shorts or dance pants over it. Tank tops can be worn over the leotard if they are fitted ~ NO LOOSE T-SHIRTS. Hair must be pulled back for all classes. Kneepads are recommended for both boys and girls. We again will be selling dancewear etc at the Dance studio.

<u>Shoe Information:</u> New shoes, except stompers will be available at the Studio on August  $16^{th}$  and throughout the year. New stompers are available for sizing the first two weeks of class beginning September 12th. There may be a shoe swap Tuesday, August 16 from 5:00-8:00 pm, or you can look in the used shoe book at the front desk.

<u>Toddler Dance Combo</u>: Black tap shoes and any color ballet shoes (rubber bottom bedroom slipper kind is okay too.)

<u>Preschool Dance Combo</u>: Black tap shoes and any color ballet shoes (rubber bottom bedroom slipper kind is okay too.)

<u>Clog-Tap/Jazz/Ballet and Clog-Tap/Jazz/Tumbling</u>: Black tap shoes and any color ballet shoe (we sell white)

<u>Pre-Competition Classes:</u> Any color ballet shoes for girls, undecided on shoes for jazz, and white clog shoes (wear last year's for now). Black tap and black jazz for boys.

Clog-tap/Jazz/Lyrical (3rd & up): Black tap shoes and tan Paul Wright 1/2 ballet shoes

Hip Hop/Jazz/ Tumbling: clean tennis shoes

Teen Dance Combo: tan Paul Wright 1/2 ballet shoes & black tap shoes (if in clogging)

Boys Hip Hop/Tumbling: Clean tennis shoes. (we will decide shoe for show later)

Ballet I: Ballet shoes any color Acro for Dancers: Barefoot

<u>Tumbling and Movement</u>: Bare foot.
